

Danish language courses for adult foreigners

When you arrive in Denmark, you have the opportunity to receive Danish language courses. Here you can read more about which requirements you must fulfil.

Newly arrived refugees and immigrants, who are covered by the Danish Integration Act, will be offered Danish language courses within one month of arrival.

The Danish language courses are free for those who are entitled to them.

You have the right to be enrolled in Danish language courses if you:

- Are registered in the population register in Gentofte
- Have a Danish CPR number
- Are a foreign citizen
- Are 18 years old

The right to Danish language courses does not cover tourists, diplomats and asylum seekers.

If you are covered by the Danish Integration Act and receive cash benefits and wish to follow Danish language courses, you must contact your social worker at the municipality.

If you are self-supporting, including au pair, you can contact Kommuneservice at Gentofte municipality.
